**2nd RENEWED NOTICE OF STANDING OBJECTION OF ABUSE OF FLORIDA
STATUTE CHAPTER 119.01**

COMES NOW, CASEY ANTHONY by and through undersigned counsel, hereby objects to the constant, Unconstitutional and abusive application of Fla. Stat. Chapter 119.01 as it relates to this cause and hereby states the following:


1. This matter is a Death Penalty Case that has garnered national attention and local obsession by the media.
2. The undersigned counsel has made repeated objections as to the application of Chapter 119.01 of the Florida Statutes.
3. The Defense has objected to information being released by Law Enforcement, the Justice Administrative Commission, Corrections, and the State Attorneys office in this matter.
4. It has been and continues to be the Defenses position that the First Amendment rights of the media must give way to the constitutionally protected rights of the accused, especially when the State seeks the ultimate penalty of death.
5. This objection is standing and continuous and the Defense invites this Honorable Court to either reverse any prior rulings as it relates to public disclosure or Sua Sponte order the aforementioned agencies to prevent any future abuses of Chapter 119.01.

6. On July 28, 2010, the media obtained via a Chapter 119 request, jail visitation logs belonging to Miss Anthony. These logs reflect Miss Anthony meeting with a Defense expert. (An example of said coverage is attached as exhibit A)
7. Having previously heard arguments on this issue, this Honorable Court denied the Defense's request to seal jail visitation logs for defense experts in this matter.
8. The purpose of the Defenses Motion was to specifically prevent this type of coverage and prejudice to the accused Miss Anthony.
9. The only purpose of this type of coverage is to embarrass, harass, humiliate the accused, poison the potential jury pool and pervade Miss Anthony's right to an adequate defense.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant CASEY MARIE ANTHONY, hereby objects to the abuse of Florida Statute Chapter 119.01, and moves this Honorable Court to find that the Defendant's 6th amendment right to a fair trial outweighs any First Amendment rights by the media and the public's so called right to know. The Defense hereby renews all previous objections to said disclosure and issues this standing objection.

ORLANDO, Fla. — As Casey Anthony prepares for her upcoming death penalty trial on first-degree murder charges, a mental health expert has begun examining the 24-year-old.

A psychologist who specializes in traumatic events has been visiting Anthony in the Orange County Jail.

Defense attorney Jose Baez said attorneys must explore potential mental health issues in any death penalty case.

Other than members of her defense team, Anthony has had few outside visitors since she was put back in jail for the final time in October 2008, but earlier this week Anthony met with Dr. Steven Gold.

Gold is a psychologist with Nova Southeastern University in Fort Lauderdale.

"Dr. Gold specializes in research, treatment of and training in psychological trauma and trauma-related disorders, disassociation, hypnosis and sexual addiction-compulsivity," Gold's website said.

Gold has written books about child abuse as well as the trauma endured by survivors of the Sept. 11 attacks.

It is not know what he and Anthony discussed during their nearly four-hour meeting.

Anthony's defense team unsuccessfully tried to block the release of her jail visitor log, fearing the public would see names, like Gold's, and unfairly speculate about their reasons for visiting.

Baez said he has a profession obligation to explore all aspects of his client's life, regardless of whether that information is used at trial.

Anthony is charged with first-degree murder in the death of her daughter, Caylee Anthony. Caylee was 2 when she was reported missing in July 2008 after being missing for a month.

Caylee's remains were found in a wooded area near the Anthony family's east Orange County home in December 2008.
