**JOINT STIPULATION REGARDING DEFENSE REVIEW OF THE
DOCUMENTS IN THE POSSESSION OF TEXAS EQUUSEARCH**

COMES NOW, Texas Equusearch, (herein after referred to as "TES"), by and through its undersigned counsel, and Defendant, CASEY ANTHONY, by and through her undersigned attorney and hereby stipulate to the following regarding the Defense request to review certain documents in the possession of TES:

1. That TES organized volunteer searcher efforts in Orange County, Florida in 2008 to search for a missing Caylee Anthony, the daughter of the Defendant, who has been charged with the death of her daughter.
2. That TES maintains the records of those searchers who volunteered their efforts to search for Caylee Anthony, estimated to be as many as several thousand individuals.
3. That the Defense had previously made an issue concerning ground conditions in the area where Caylee Anthony's remains were ultimately discovered. In response to the issue of ground conditions having become relevant to the Defense, TES provided the records of 32 searchers, who were determined to have searched within approximately a 50 yard area from where Caylee was discovered.

4. That the Defense wishes to contact additional searchers to determine if any of them searched the Suburban Drive area, where Caylee was found, through organized TES efforts or whether they went to the Suburban Drive area and conducted an independent search.

5. That TES has a great concern about protecting the private information and disclosure of those volunteer searchers, especially those who were not in the immediate area where Caylee was discovered.

6. That to protect the privacy of the TES searchers and to accommodate the Defense's desire to conduct a full investigation in preparation of their client's defense, this Stipulation has been entered into as to fully address the concerns and stated needs of both TES and the Defense. The terms of the Stipulation are as follows:

A. That the Honorable Belvin Perry, the presiding judge, shall appoint Magistrate James Glatt, to oversee the Defense review of the TES documents and to enforce the terms and conditions of the review. The review shall take place at a designated place within the Orange County Courthouse, unless another place may be mutually agreed upon by the parties,

B. That a TES representative shall also be present at all times during the review of the documents. TES counsel is also permitted to be present. The TES representative shall deliver the documents to the review site location and shall leave with the documents upon the conclusion of each review day.

C. That the Defense shall be permitted to have its representative(s) conduct a review of all searcher files. Any individuals who are contained in the various searcher files may be permitted to be telephoned but only in front of the TES representative, its counsel and the Magistrate, for the sole purpose of asking the searcher:

Were you involved in any search, involving or not involving TES, in the Suburban Drive area? If the answer is in the negative, then no further questions will be asked and the call terminated. If the answer is in the positive, then the following questions will be permitted to be asked:

1. If such a search occurred, when did the search occur,
2. If such a search occurred, was it a part of TES or done independently,
3. If such a search occurred, who was involved in the search with them,
4. If such a search occurred, an inquiry would be made as to what was observed and what occurred during the search at or near the Suburban Drive area.


D. In the event after the above questions are asked, the Defense determines that further investigation or questioning is appropriate, then the search field activity form of the identified searcher shall be released to the Defense so they may conduct their further investigation as they may deem appropriate.

E. That the names of any of the searchers or any information contained within the TES files shall not be disclosed, directly or indirectly, to the media or to any other individual or entity, or published in a manner whatsoever, without written stipulation of the parties or a specific court order. This procedure eliminates the need of note taking by the defense, other than identifying those searchers who were unable to be reached for further follow up, unless a call identifies a searcher who has relevant information concerning anyone who has information as to who may have searched the Suburban Drive area. If a searcher indicates they were not in the Suburban Drive area then their information shall not be released further to the Defense and the Defense is not permitted to secure or leave with any of their information.


F. That the above terms and conditions are intended to protect the privacy of individuals who donated their time to TES, without fear of public disclosure and to also insure the Defendant's ability to have her counsel conduct what they determine to be a meaningful investigation on her behalf in preparation of her defense.

G. That the Defense's review of the records is considered to be work product as to the preparation of their defense.

H. That this Stipulation shall be presented to the Honorable Belvin Perry for purposes of being incorporated into a Court Order, directing the parties to comply with the terms and conditions set forth herein and supersedes and replaces any other order addressing the issues herein.






