**ORDER ADDRESSING DEFENDANT'S AMENDED MOTION  
FOR ADDITIONAL HOURS OF INVESTIGATION AND  
MOTION TO APPROVE PRIOR TRAVEL OF OUT OF STATE EXPERTS**


THIS MATTER came before the Court for hearing on December 14, 2010 to address Defendant's Amended Motion for Additional Hours of Investigation and Motion to Approve Prior Travel of Out of State Experts. Upon hearing arguments of counsel from Defendant and the Justice Administrative Commission (hereinafter referred to as "JAC"), it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:**

**Defendant's Amended Motion for Additional Hours of Investigation:** Defendant requests authorization for an additional 300 hours for investigative services. At this hearing, defense counsel informed the Court that the reason for this request is that there are 110 persons remaining to interview who are listed as category A witnesses on the State's witness list.

Accordingly, an additional **110 hours** for investigative services is **GRANTED**. Defense counsel shall coordinate with JAC to ensure that the past and future billings submitted for investigative services are in compliance with JAC's policies and procedures as to the approved rates and type of services that the investigator may bill for. Defense counsel is reminded that there are certain services that may not be paid for by JAC.

**Defendant's Motion to Approve Prior Travel of Out of State Experts:** The Court's review and ruling on this motion is postponed pending submission by defense counsel of an itemized statement of the experts' travel expenses incurred. Defense counsel shall submit the itemized statement to the Court with copies to JAC and the State by **December 21, 2010**.
