ORDER DENYING MOTION TO
RESTRICT IN-COURT PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOING

This matter came before the Court for consideration of this defense Motion, which was filed December 30, 2010.

The defense alleges the telephoto lens used by the still photographer in the courtroom for each hearing has been used to take photos of documents and notes being reviewed by counsel and the defendant. The defense also alleges that video cameras have been used to view messages between counsel and the defendant and that conversations have been broadcast and distributed to the media. This Motion seeks an order prohibiting the use of any telephoto equipment and the removal of any microphone or broadcasting equipment that would be capable of overhearing conversations.

It is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. The Motion to Restrict In-Court Photography / Videoing is DENIED. There is no prohibition against the use of a telephoto lens.


2. The photo attached to the Motion as Exhibit "A" shows the defendant looking at a photocopy of a court opinion. The defense has not identified any photographs where

photographs of readable notes have been taken or released to the media. To clarify, there will be no dissemination of photographs or videotape containing the substance of any notes or conversations between attorney and client.

3. The defense team shall be permitted to use the table at the side of Courtroom 23A, where no one will be behind them or in a position to see their notes.

4. The courtroom microphones have been modified so that they may now be turned off. It is counsel's responsibility to make sure conversations are not overheard.


