

This motion was filed by the defense on November 17, 2008. The parties have stipulated that it was rendered moot because the information has already been provided pursuant to a public records demand.


Therefore, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Motion to Compel K9 Information is hereby DISMISSED.
