ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AUTHORIZE
AND COMPEL PREPARATION OF TRANSCRIPTS

This matter came before the Court for consideration of this defense Motion, which was filed December 3, 2010.

The defense alleges that court reporters providing service for the depositions of expert witnesses connected to the Oak Ridge National Laboratory in Knoxville, Tennessee had agreed to work for “indigency rates.” However, upon completion of the depositions and request for transcripts, the court reporter service declined to “discount” the cost of the transcripts. The defense seeks an order authorizing funding for the preparation of these transcripts. The estimated cost is \$2,500.00, whereas the JAC will pay only \$1,639.30, a difference of \$860.70.


It is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. The Motion to Authorize and Compel Preparation of Transcripts is GRANTED to authorize payment in full to Stogsdill Court Reporting Services.

2. In the future, the parties shall be required to obtain a contract confirming that

the court reporting service will accept the JAC rate. If the service will not accept said rate, the parties shall be required to submit the tapes to court administration for transcription.
