**ORDER GRANTING OBJECTION TO RELEASE OF DOCUMENTS
RELATED TO INTENDED DEFENSE REVIEW OF EVIDENCE**


THIS MATTER came before the Court for hearing on July 15, 2010 to address Defendant's Objection to Release of Documents Related to Intended Defense Review of Evidence dated July 12, 2010 and filed July 14, 2010. Based upon review of the Objection, and hearing arguments of counsel, the Court makes the below findings:

The instant Objection filed by Defendant addresses documents pertaining to particular items requested by defense counsel from the evidence list compiled by counsel from both parties and e-mailed by defense counsel to the undersigned Judge as requested. The list included documents and/or related items of evidence in the custody of the Sheriff of Orange County, Florida, for inspection by defense counsel. These items have previously been disclosed in discovery and provided as a public record in the past. Such inspection occurred on July 13 and 14, 2010. Defendant claims that this case carries on in its investigation stages and that documents related to this request are work product. Therefore, Defendant requests that the release of said documents to the media be denied. Further, no motions to intervene were filed nor brought before the Court at the July 15, 2010 hearing by any interested media entity to address the instant Objection.

Based on the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:

Defendant's Objection to Release of Documents Related to Intended Defense Review of Evidence is **GRANTED**. Accordingly, documents pertaining to particular items requested by the defense counsel from the evidence list shall not be released to the media.
