ORDER REGARDING DEPOSITION SCHEDULE


This matter came before the Court on April 30, 2010 for a Case Management Hearing pursuant to Rule 2.085(b) of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration.

The State has listed over 250 witnesses and estimates the defense will seek to depose approximately 90 of those witnesses. The Defense indicates that 36 depositions have been taken to date. .
