ORDER ON RENEWED MOTION TO COMPEL BENCH NOTES,  
STANDARDS, DATA, AND COMMUNICATIONS WITH LAW  
ENFORCEMENT, ET AL.

This matter came to be heard on May 10, 2010 on the Renewed Motion to Compel Bench Notes, Standards, Data, and Communications with Law Enforcement, Et Al., filed August 20, 2009. The defense began legal argument regarding discovery it has requested but not received. However, as presented, the Court found the request to be too general. It was too difficult to address each claim without knowing exactly what the defense was missing or whether the defense was entitled to every item requested. The State asked that the defense be directed to file a new, more specific motion, so the State could coordinate with its experts and produce the items to which the defense was entitled.

It is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:


1. The Court reserves ruling. The defense shall list specific items of discovery it has requested but not received from specific witnesses. The defense shall provide this list within 10 days and the State shall provide a written response within 10 days.

2. The defense shall rearrange its Motion so the State can respond to whether the requested items exist, do not exist, or argue that the material has been previously provided or that the defense is not entitled to it.

3. The State shall provide discovery, as agreed, pursuant to the defense's specific request for reports from the following, whom the State concedes are expert witnesses:

James Darnell, William Moore, Cary Oien, Kevin Stenger, and Brandon Giroux.
