**RENEWED NOTICE OF STANDING OBJECTION OF ABUSE OF FLORIDA
STATUTE CHAPTER 119.01**

COMES NOW, CASEY ANTHONY by and through undersigned counsel, hereby objects to the constant, Unconstitutional and abusive application of Fla. Stat. Chapter 119.01 as it relates to this cause and hereby states the following:


1. This matter is a Death Penalty Case that has garnered national attention and local obsession by the media.
2. The undersigned counsel has made repeated objections as to the application of Chapter 119.01 of the Florida Statutes.
3. The Defense has objected to information being released by Law Enforcement, the Justice Administrative Commission, Corrections, and the State Attorneys office in this matter.
4. It has been and continues to be the Defenses position that the First Amendment rights of the media must give way to the constitutionally protected rights of the accused, especially when the State seeks the ultimate penalty of death.
5. This objection is standing and continuous and the Defense invites this Honorable Court to either reverse any prior rulings as it relates to public disclosure or Sua Sponte order the aforementioned agencies to prevent any future abuses of Chapter 119.01.
6. On July 19, 2010, the media obtained via a Chapter 119 request, billing records of a Defense Investigator from the Judicial Administrative Commission and reported that there is a "shift of

- blame" in the Defense of Casey Anthony (An example of said coverage is attached as exhibit A and B)
7. Having previously heard arguments on this issue, this Honorable Court denied the Defense's request to seal all JAC records in this matter.
 8. The purpose of the Defenses Motion was to specifically prevent this type of coverage and prejudice to the accused Miss Anthony.
 9. Miss Anthony must endure this type of prejudice solely because of her status of being indigent, whereas a Defendant who can afford their own defense would not be required to send billing records to a governmental agency.
 10. The only purpose of this type of coverage is to embarrass, harass, humiliate the accused, poison the potential jury pool and pervade Miss Anthony's right to an adequate defense.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant CASEY MARIE ANTHONY, hereby objects to the abuse of Florida Statute Chapter 119.01, and moves this Honorable Court to find that the Defendant's 6th amendment right to a fair trial outweighs any First Amendment rights by the media and the public's so called right to know. The Defense hereby renews all previous objections to said disclosure and issues this standing objection.

Casey's Defense Investigates George Anthony

Baez Says Team Must 'Investigate Everything'

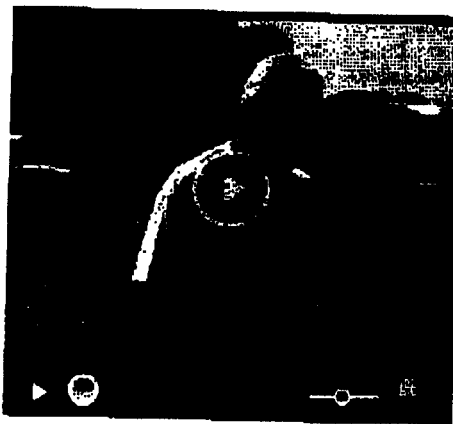

ORLANDO, Fla. -- Casey Anthony's defense attorney, Jose Baez, acknowledged that his team is investigating his client's father, George Anthony.

George was the only member of the Anthony family to testify before the grand jury that indicted Casey for murder. In an interview with the FBI, George claimed that Casey stole from her parents and from Caylee.

In last week's hearing, Cindy Anthony testified that in her first 911 calls, she was repeating George's opinion that Casey's car smelled like it had a dead body inside.

Now, Casey's defense is investigating George. Sources tell WESH 2 that the defense has focused on his 2009 suicide attempt.

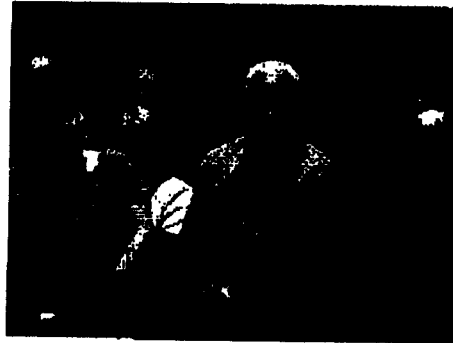

Baez told WESH 2, "We're obligated to investigate everything."

"The loss of Caylee and the pain it has caused the family is very relevant to mitigation," Baez said.

Once a jury has found



someone guilty of first-degree murder, mitigation is testimony offered by the defenses to convince the jury to vote for life instead of death. George Anthony's attorney, Brad Conway, said mitigation evidence would involve events that lead up to Caylee's death.

"They're going to have to prove the relevancy of a suicide attempt after the fact," Conway said.

Conway said the defense's investigation comes as no surprise to him.

"I expected they would investigate George just like any other witness," Conway said. "We've cooperated with the defense and the state attorney's office transparently."

ORLANDO, Fla. -- There is a shift of the blame in the case against Casey Anthony. Documents released only to WFTV Monday show, for the first time, Casey's lawyers are investigating her father. WFTV legal analyst Bill Sheaffer said the defense may be trying to discredit him, or possibly blame George Anthony.

The documents WFTV obtained show how the defense is spending taxpayer money. Some of the ways the lawyers are spending that limited money is investigating George Anthony.

George testified against his daughter in her grand jury hearing.

J

The defense has spent about \$4,000 of taxpayers' money so far on Casey's defense, and most of it on its private investigator.

Records obtained by WFTV show the defense is investigating George Anthony's suicide attempt. They did it to her ex-fiance, Jesse Grund, who was willing to raise another man's child as his own. The defense did it to meter reader Roy Kronk, who found Caylee Anthony's remains near the Anthonys' home on Hopespring Drive.

Now, the defense team could be doing it to Casey Anthony's father, trying to discredit George. Records show her defense team's private eye has investigated George's suicide attempt the month after Caylee was found.

"The defense will have to discredit George, because George has some information that is damning to the defense," Sheaffer said *(full interview)*.

Sheaffer says George's testimony helped prosecutors get a first-degree murder indictment against Casey even before her daughter's body was found. George said her car trunk smelled like a dead body and that, days after Caylee disappeared, Casey came home unexpectedly and prevented George from going into the trunk of her car.

At taxpayers' expense, the defense team spent hours at the Hawaii Motel in Daytona where George tried to take his own life. They also were at the Daytona Beach Police Department getting records.

"They would want to show he was mentally unstable," Sheaffer said.

Sheaffer says the defense might go even farther to try to make some jurors wonder whether George is the murderer; Casey could have laid the groundwork by accusing her father of sexually abusing her.

"He was the last person to see Caylee, along with Casey. The duct tape came from his house. The heart stickers came from his house," Sheaffer said.

If the defense can't convince a jury that George or someone else covered Caylee's face with duct tape and stuck a heart sticker over her mouth, they might try to use George's suicide attempt to portray Casey's family as dysfunctional to spare her from a possible death sentence.

NEXT IN THE CASE AGAINST CASEY

The defense is asking for a hearing to seal Jose Baez's phone conversation with inmate, Robin Lunceford.

Meanwhile, a status hearing is scheduled for August 30.

The defense is also expected to depose eleven people next month.
