SECOND AMENDED ORDER SETTING DISCOVERY,  
MOTION and HEARING DEADLINES and TRIAL DATE

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard on the Motion of the State of Florida to set a discovery schedule, and this Court having solicited proposed timelines for same from both parties, and otherwise being duly advised in the premises, HEREBY ORDERS as follows:

**1. DISCOVERY ORDER AS TO EXPERT WITNESSES**

- a) Depositions of expert witnesses listed by the State of Florida shall be completed no later than September 30, 2010.
- b) Evidence review by any defense expert witnesses shall be completed no later than October 31, 2010.
- c) The Defendant shall (1) list all expert witnesses she intends to call at hearing or trial, (2) provide any reports prepared by those expert witnesses and (3) file any motions related to the forensic/scientific evidence no later than November 30, 2010.
- d) Depositions of expert witnesses listed by the Defendant shall be completed no later than February 28, 2011.
- e) Motions related to the forensic/scientific evidence shall be heard no later than February 28, 2011.

**2. EXCHANGE OF WITNESS LISTS AND EVIDENCE SCHEDULES FOR  
MOTION HEARINGS**

Not later than two full working days before a hearing, both parties are to exchange and file with the Court a list of all witnesses and a schedule of all exhibits which the party will offer at the hearing. Additionally, expert witnesses shall be designated as such.

**3. DISCOVERY ORDER AS TO LAW ENFORCEMENT WITNESSES**

- a) Depositions of law enforcement officers or employees were previously ordered to be completed by September 30, 2010. Based upon a request of the defense and by mutual agreement between the state and defense, the depositions of law enforcement officers or employees is extended until October 31, 2010.
- b) All non-forensic/scientific evidentiary motions shall be filed no later than November 30, 2010 and heard no later than December 31, 2010.

**4. DISCOVERY ORDER AS TO ALL OTHER WITNESSES**

- a) All other witnesses shall be listed no later than August 31, 2010.
- b) Depositions of all other witnesses shall be completed by October 31, 2010.

**5. GENERAL DISCOVERY ORDER**

Once a witness becomes known to the Defendant, she shall decide within 5 working days whether the witness will be listed pursuant to F.R.C.P. 3.220 (d)(1)(A). In no event shall any witness be listed or deposed, by either party, outside the time limits provided in this order. In the absence of a stipulation, it will be the burden of the listing or deposing party to show good cause for any delay to this Court.

**6. ORDER AS TO ALL OTHER MOTIONS**

Non-forensic/scientific legal motions requiring no testimony before the court shall be filed and heard no later than December 31, 2010.

**7. ORDER AS TO PENALTY PHASE WITNESSES**

All penalty phase witnesses shall be listed by November 30, 2010. All depositions of penalty phase witnesses shall be completed by February 28, 2011.

**8. THIS CAUSE IS HEREBY SET FOR TRIAL BEGINNING MAY 9, 2011.**

Time and location to be determined by further order of this Court.


**9. STATUS CONFERENCES**
