

DAILY SCHEDULE FOR MATTERS IN COURTROOM 6D AND BRC 3

MONDAY THRU FRIDAY- The following matters are handled by the circuit criminal judges on a rotating basis:

8:30 a.m. In custody misdemeanor pleas
In custody felony pleas (only negotiated pleas will be accepted)

Both misdemeanor and felony pleas require a plea form. This is a change from the previous process.

9:30 a.m. Bond hearings for misdemeanors
Bond hearings for felonies
Violation of conditional release hearings

These bond hearings are limited to no more than 15 minutes per hearing.

11:00 a.m. Felony pleas for out of custody cases (negotiated only)

FRIDAY Circuit Criminal on rotating basis

1:30 p.m. Bond & Arthur hearings over 15 minutes
Any other essential matter from any division (ex. Habeas corpus)
Non-essential felony matters with in custody defendants
