

DIVISION 72 COVID-19 PROCEDURES:

The Court is in the process of sending out notices of all the hearings that were cancelled due to COVID-19 quarantine. If a self-represented litigant is involved, the Court will re-notice the hearing. If both parties are represented by counsel, counsel should reschedule. Please make all hearing notices telephonic. The Court has a conference call number that we can provide for the hearing notice if you do not have that capability. Non-jury trials and evidentiary hearings will be conducted via video conference. If you know of any such hearing that was cancelled or scheduled through the end of May, please email the Judicial Assistant (72orange@ninthcircuit.org) with the case number and names and the Court will re-notice those matters with the video conference language and instructions. Due to the time required to send out notices, telephonic and video proceedings will continue at least through the end of May. The Court will allow the use of this technology after that time as well.
